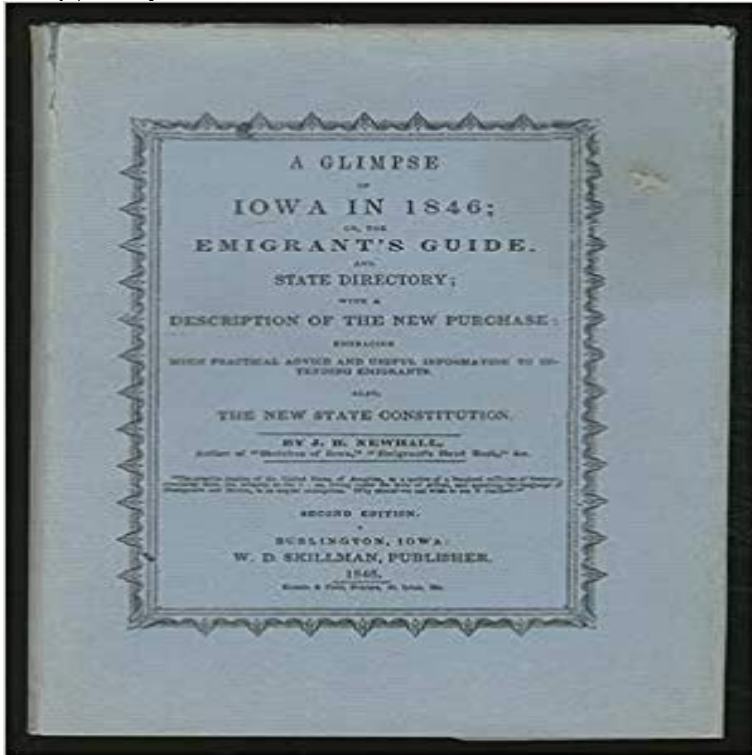


A glimpse of Iowa in 1846
