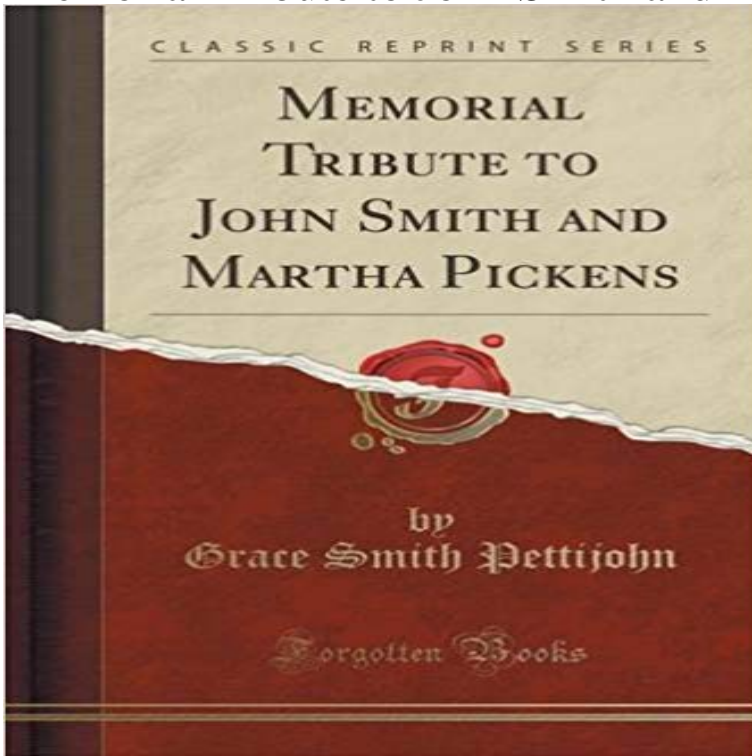


Memorial Tribute to John Smith and Martha Pickens (Classic Reprint)
